



## Stuck at Home Stash Cowl

**Yarn:** 200 yards of worsted yarn- 100 yards of each color

(I used pink color 36619 and red color 51450 of Clinton Hill Bespoke Cashmere -99 yards each purchased at my favorite local yarn store, Pick Up Every Stitch in Mt. Kisco NY)

**Gauge:** 16 stitches=4 inches in stockinette stitch but gauge doesn't matter that much. However a different gauge may use more or less yarn.

**Needles:** 16 or 24 inch circular size 8 or size to get gauge.

**Finished size=** 12 ½ by 10 inches after blocking

### Directions:

**With color A,** cast on 112 stitches and join in the round.

Knit 1 row

Purl 1 row

Knit 1 row

### Switch to Color B

**Row 1:** (Kfb, K4, SSK, K2tog, Knit 4, KFB) 9 times

**Row 2:** Knit

Repeat 2 row repeat alternating between colors until approximately 8 ½ inches long ending with Color A.

### Bind off Contrast Edge section

1. Change to Color B and repeat Row 1
2. Purl one row with Color B
3. Repeat Row 1
4. Bind off all stitches in Color B
